

NOTICE as of January 12, 2021

Children's Centre Thunder Bay is open and providing our full range of services

- ✓ Monday and Friday from 8:30 to 4:30
- ✓ Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 8am to 6 pm

We are accepting referrals for all of our services. Given the variable presence of Covid-19 across Ontario and increase in cases in our District, we continue to follow Government Directives and Public Health advice to ensure that staff and clients are safe. The following Infection Prevention and Control measures are in place at our Centre.

- **SCREENING** - All employees, clients and community guests must complete our screening assessment using GOEVO application prior to entering CCTB work spaces. If you are a client you can do this with your worker or reception if needed
- **TRAVEL** outside of the CCTB restricted zone. – If you or any person living in your household have travelled outside of Northwestern Ontario, we require that you not attend in person any of our worksites (office, residence or client home) for a symptom-free period of 7 days from point of entry.
- **HAND HYGIENE** – All people entering our work places must follow proper hand hygiene and sanitize upon entry, and on a regular basis throughout the day
- **MASKS** – masks are required when you are in any common areas of the building or worksites. We have masks available for those who need one. Once you in an office or counselling space and can physically distance you may remove your mask if you so choose.
- **DISTANCING** – you are required to maintain recommended physical distancing requirements. This includes limiting room occupancy to recommended number identified for the area/room.
- **VIRTUAL SERVICES** – although most services are being provided in-person, some are being provided virtually or though telepractice only. We encourage you to discuss service options with your worker or reception
- **SICK** - If you are sick do not come to our office or other work spaces. If you have an appointment please call your worker and follow public health advice regarding self-isolation
